Jones, Registered Engineer, dated November 1, 1962, caused by the overflow of Richland Creek, and the accumulation of surface water within the boundaries of the streets designated on the said revised plat of SWANSON COURT, provided that the said damages, if any, are not caused directly or indirectly by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, its agents or servants.

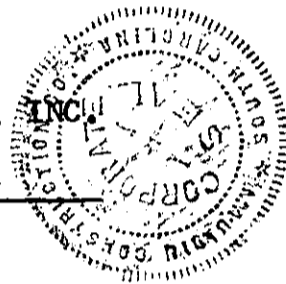
