Master in and for the County aforesaid, toEugene_Barton
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Preesents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$100.00
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
nto the said Eugene Barton
"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying between the Paper Mill Road, and the Spur Track, running to Donaldson Air Force Base, and having according to a plat of property of J. C. Bailey and Mattie Lee Bailey, prepared by W. J. Riddle, September 1948, the following courses and discances to-wit:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Paper Mill Road at the corner of property belonging to the Mount Pleasant School, being the northest corner of the lot herein conveyed, and running thence along said road 3-12 W. 128.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along a new line N. 76-33 E. 18.9 feet to an iron pin; thence along the right-of-way of said Spur Track 29-02 W. 139.7 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Mount Pleasant chool property S. 61-45 W. 45.9 feet to the point of beginning. See Deed ook 609, at Page 94."
The Decree of the Greenville County Court, in the above entitled action, under date of September 27, 1962, provided that the interest of the J. C. Bailey heirs, to which Mary Barton was entitled to under said order of Court, be conveyed to her or to her assignee, by E. Inman, as laster, and the said Mary Barton having assigned said interest to Eugene.
