**CHARTER**  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

did on the 3rd day of December, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is ORRS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 206 West McBee Avenue, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to sell and render services to the general public in personal and social development, including, but not limited to, schooling and instruction in dancing and related skills, recitals, parties and public demonstrations, of every kind and description related directly or indirectly to personality and social development, and to do any acts in furtherance of, incidental or conducive to aforesaid objectives and purposes; and to do any acts or things which are now authorized, or may in the future be authorized, under the laws of the State of South Carolina relating to corporations.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars payable in cash or property at the call of the Directors

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Fifty (50) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 30th day of November, 1962, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: C. Richard Orr, Jacqueline E. Orr

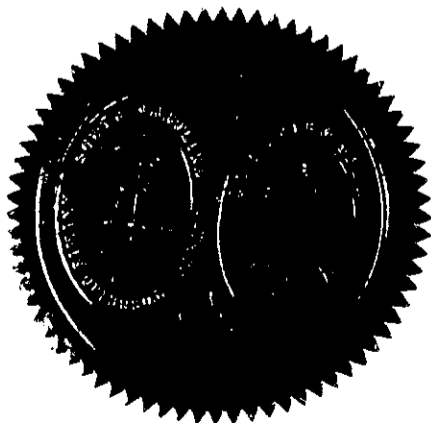
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, C. Richard Orr ;  
as Vice-President, Jacqueline E. Orr ; as Secretary, Jacqueline E. Orr ;  
as Treasurer, C. Richard Orr

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville News a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
