BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Mayflower Avenue, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10 and running thence along said Avenue N. 17-33 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9; thence along the joint side of line of said Lots S. 72-27 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence S. 17-33 W. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10; thence along the joint side line of said Lots N. 72-27 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

As a part of the consideration hereof, the grantee agrees to assume and pay, according to its terms, the principal balance of that certain note and mortgage to C. Douglas Wilson & Co., recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgages Vol. 668, page 63. The balance due as of this date on said mortgage is \$7,783.74.
