KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. P. Medlock, of Greenville County,

in consideration of Eighteen Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 - - - - - Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Chalmers LeRoyce Wise, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot #38 as shown on a plat of Oakwood Acres, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, dated September 1959, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book MM, at page 135, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern edge of Oakwood Avenue, the joint front corner of Lots #38 and #37, and running thence along the line of these lots, S. 22-55 E. 175 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 60-50 W. 92.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots #38 and #39; running thence N. 25-58 W. 176.6 feet to an iron pin on the southern edge of Oakwood Avenue; running thence along the southern edge of Oakwood Avenue, N. 62-42 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning; being the same property conveyed to me by Leslie & Shaw, Inc. by its deed dated August 14, 1962 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 705, at Page 392.
