times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said water pump and making the necessary repairs and replacements.

(3) Also the further right, privilege and easement to take and, use water jointly with the Grantor, from the well located on the property of Grantor above described, in an amount adequate and sufficient for use on Grantee's farmstead and dwelling located on property lying West of and adjacent to Grantor's property above.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED, that said right of way and easement will run from the location of the well, which well is located on property of the Grantor at a point on the East side of the proposed or future road on the above mentioned un-numbered tract and runs generally in ta Northwesterly and Westerly direction across said proposed road and across the front portion of Lot No. 8 for a distance of approximately 310 feet to the East side of the property of the Grantee herein.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED that the owner, PETER H. WUEST, is to have the same privileges and right to cultivate and use the right of way strip as he had prior to this agreement, provided that such use thereof will not interfere with the proper operation and maintenance of the said water line.
