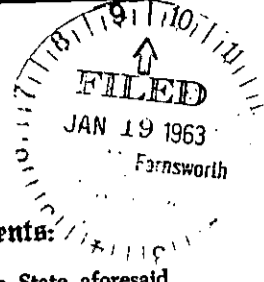

Know All Men by These Presents:

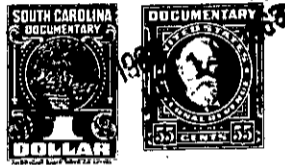

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Azile C. Cope the following-described property:

Lot 64-T of Springwood Cemetery, City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following dimensions:

North 11 feet, East 12 feet; South 11 feet, and West 12 feet, for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the rights and purposes aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the charter of the City of Greenville, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the ordinances of said city and the rules and regulations and By-Laws of the City Council and Cemetery Committee now in force or which may hereafter be passed relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

The above-described property is the same conveyed to Mrs. Lillian Gaines Lewis by the City of Greenville on June 5, 1945, the deed being recorded in Deed Book 226, Page 327. The said Lillian Gaines Lewis died testate on April 9, 1962. (See Apartment 792, File 1, Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, South Carolina).



TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) successors Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) successors Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Witness the grantor's(s) hand and seal this 18th day of January, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and sixty-three.
