
Dear Mr. McFadden:

This will acknowledge the receipt of Agreement of Merger of Ivey-Keith Company, A South Carolina corporation, and J. B. Ivey & Company, A North Carolina corporation, the surviving corporation being the North Carolina corporation, the merger agreement being filed as provided by Act No. 156 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1957. We likewise acknowledge the receipt of the \$10.00 as required by law in this case which covers the merger and the Declaration naming the Secretary of State as agent for service of process.

Under the merger agreement, insofar as our records are concerned, the South Carolina corporation goes out of existence and the foreign corporation, as of this date, has not domesticated in South Carolina.

Our records have been marked accordingly and a copy of this letter is being sent to the South Carolina Tax Commission and to the Register of Mesne Convoyance of Greenville County with the request that they mark their records accordingly.
