

WHEREAS, said James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman have agreed, and do hereby agree, to permit said Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman to use water jointly with them from the well located on the property of James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman, and said C. N. Pittman and Velma M. Pittman have agreed, and do hereby agree, to permit said Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman to construct and maintain a water pipe line across the property which they now own adjacent to the above described property of Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman to connect with the well located on the property of James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein, and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) to the undersigned in hand paid by Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we, C. N. Pittman, Velma M. Pittman, James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman, do hereby grant unto Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman, their heirs and assigns,

(1) The right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the property owned by C. N. Pittman and Velma M. Pittman lying adjacent to the above described property owned by Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman which is a portion of the property conveyed in Deed Vol. 261, at page 222, which property lies southeasterly from the property of Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman, and also the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the property of James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman which is identified on the Township Block Book at Sheet 615.1, Block 1, Lot 18.1, and to construct and maintain in and upon and through said premises in a proper manner a 1-inch water pipe line and other necessary apparatus incident thereto, using the necessary appliances and machinery for such work for the purpose of conveying water from the well located on the property of James Bailey Pittman and Mildred C. Pittman through the premises above described to the house located on the property of Harold N. Pittman and Joyce Pittman with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said water line and making the necessary repairs thereon.

(2) Together with the right, privilege and easement to install, operate and maintain a water pump at the well located on the property of James Bailey Pittman
