. FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is SPARR STORES OF SOUTH CAROLINA, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 409 E. North Street, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To manufacture or otherwise produce, purchase or otherwise acquire, to sell or otherwise dispose of at whole-sale or retail, for cash, on credit or otherwise, and generally deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise and personal property of every class, kind and description.

To purchase, erect, own, hold, use, operate, manage, develop and improve, and to sell, lease, let, mortgage, exchange, convey and otherwise dispose of lands, tenements, hereditaments and the buildings thereon or any interest therein.

To transact a general real estate agency and brokerage business, including the management of estates; to act as broker or attorney in fact for any person or corporation in buying, selling and dealing in real property and any and every estate and interest therein, and choses in action secured thereby, judgment resulting therefrom, and other personal property collateral thereto, in making or obtaining loans upon such property, in supervising, managing and protecting such property and loans and all interests in and claims affecting the same, in effecting insurance against fire and all other risks thereon in connection with business relating to any of the purposes herein mentioned or referred to; to cause to be registered mortgages and deeds of trust of real property or chattels real and all other securities collateral thereto; to purchase and hold real property and any and every estate therein, and choses in action secured thereby, judgment resulting therefrom, and other personal property collateral thereto; to improve, manage, operate, sell, mortgage, lease and otherwise dispose of any property so acquired; to loan upon such property, and to take mortgages and assignments of mortgages of the same.

To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise, and to receive, hold, own, deal in, underwrite, sell, exchange or otherwise dispose of, pledge or hypothecate, all kinds of stocks, bonds, mortgages, debentures, trust receipts, notes, voting trust certificates, warrants, participation certificates, interim receipts and other securities, obligations, contracts, certificates of interest, choses in action and evidence of indebtedness, of any corporation, association, firm, syndicate, trust, person, government, state, colony, municipality or of any other organization; to acquire or become interested in any of the foregoing by original subscription, underwriting, participating in underwriting and in syndicates, or otherwise, including borrowing for deliveries against sales previously made, and to enter into trading accounts and joint accounts with respect to the same, and irrespective of whether or not such stocks, securities or other obligations are fully paid or subject to further payment; to receive, collect, and dispose of interest, dividends and income upon, of and from any of the foregoing and any other property held or owned by it, and to exercise any and all rights, powers and privileges of individual ownership or interest in respect of any of the foregoing, including the right to vote thereon, for any and all purposes; and to do any and all acts and things for the preservation, protection, improvement and enhancement in value thereof, and to guarantee the same or become surety in respect thereof, and to aid by loan, subsidy, guaranty, or otherwise, those issuing, creating or responsible for the same.
