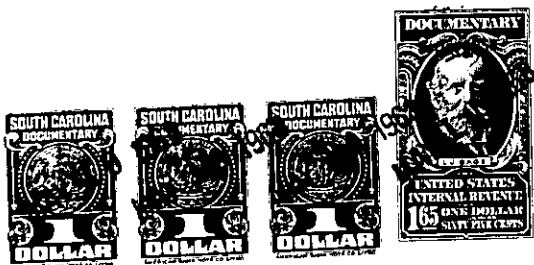

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with any improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the western side of West Castle Road in Pine Hill Village, Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, shown and designated as Lot 177 and the adjoining, northernmost 3 feet of Lot 178 on a plat of Pine Hill Village, prepared by R. K. Campbell, R.L.S., dated July 9, 1962, and recorded in the Office of the R.M.C. for said County and State in Plat Book "QQ", Page 168, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of West Castle Road, joint front corner of Lots 176 and 177, and running thence N. 66-14 W. 130 feet along the joint line of said lots to an iron pin, joint rear corner of said lots; thence S. 23-46 W. 73 feet to a point in the rear line of Lot 178; thence S. 66-14 E. 130 feet through Lot 178 and along the new line between Lots 177 and 178, to a point on the western side of said Road, new joint front corner of said lots; thence N. 23-46 E. 73 feet along the western side of said Road to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
