in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of \$5.00 and Love and Affection _____ Dollars

to us _____ in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Rometta Young Moon

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rometta Young Moon, her heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina with all buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being just outside the Corporate Limits of the City of Greenville, on the East side of Mission Street (formerly Church Street) and known and designated as LOT NO. 12, Block C, of the O. P. Mills property as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book C, at page 284, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Mission Street, joint corner of Lots 12 and 13, and running thence North 53-18 East 200 feet to an iron pin; thence North 36-50 West 55 feet to corner of Lot No. 11; thence with Lot No. 11, South 53-18 West 200 feet to an iron pin on Mission Street; running thence with Mission Street, South 36-51 East 55 feet to the beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed by J. B. McCall, et al to H. A. Moon by deed dated January 22, 1947 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 306, at page 322.

The said H. A. Moon died intestate in Greenville County on November 6, 1959 and the above named Grantors and Grantee constitute all his heirs at law.
