

NOW, THEREFORE, in exchange of the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter set out, the undersigned Addie T. Watson and Ann W. Long do grant unto R. F. Solley, his heirs and assigns forever, the right to construct a water line across their property for approximately 1000 feet, more or less, to the right of way of the Greenville City Water Works line and the additional right to maintain and keep in good repair said line and to go upon their property for the purpose of carrying out this maintenance and repairs, said easement to run appurtenant to the land and it shall be binding on the heirs and assigns of Addie T. Watson and Ann W. Long. The undersigned R. F. Solley does hereby grant unto Addie T. Watson and Ann W. Long, their heirs and assigns forever, the right of ingress and egress of a road roughly referred to as a "County Road", being approximately 20 feet in width, said road running through the property obtained by R. F. Solley from Willard G. Wade by deed recorded in Deed Book 714 at page 59, RMC Office for Greenville County.. This right of ingress and egress shall run appurtenant to the land and shall be binding upon the said R. F. Solley, his heirs and assigns forever.
