It is distinctly understood that said lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the White race, and is sold and conveyed subject to all rules and regulations printed on deed of William Cox recorded in R. M. C. office of Greenville County in Vol. 80" Page 197, June 10th 1921, and any additions or amendments for the government of the Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.
