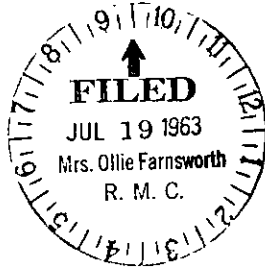

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Cooley, his Heirs and Assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near Piedmont, Greenville County, South Carolina, on South side of dirt road running Northwest from Gin Road to East Main Street; bounded on the North by said road, on East and South by lands of George W. Cooper and on the West by Lot 167 and George W. Cooper.

The foregoing land was conveyed to grantor by deed of George W. Cooper, April 14, 1961, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County.
