1. Both parties do hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of the Lease Agreement dated November 4, 1957, between KEK Co., Inc. and Charles C. Switzer, as Lessors, and The Keever Starch Company, as Lessee, referred to above, the following described real estate:

recited, the parties hereto do hereby agree:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being on the northeasterly side of W. Antrim Drive, in the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as Lot 1-A on a survey plat made for Keever Starch Co. by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated 2 March, 1963, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "DDD", page 53, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
