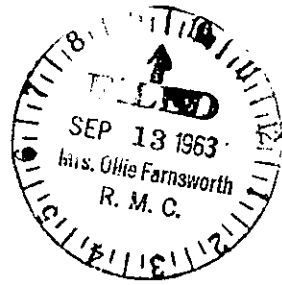

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lois Caldwell Harrison, Her Heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece or parcel or tract of land, situated, lying and being in Glassy Mountain Twonship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, With a small portian in Spartanburg County, South Carolina, Bounded now or formerly as follows;

On the North by lands of J . S Carpenter, South Pacolet River, being the line;  
 On the East by lands of J C Caldwell and by lot #4 in the sub-division of the Ralph S Crowell lands, which lot is being conveyed by deed of even date to C S West; On the South by lot #3 in sub-division of Ralph S Crowell lands, which lot is being conveyed by deed of even date to R V Reynolds, and on the West by lot #2 in the sub-division of the Ralph S Crowell lands, which lot is being conveyed by deed of even date to Beuford E Pace, and by lands of K V Settle, and being more particulary bounded and described as follows;

Being lot #1 in the sub-division of the lands of Ralph S Crowell, acquired by deed from Victor M Montgomery, dated July 6, 1950, recorded in book 9-F, page 146 Office of R M C, for Spartanburg County, beginning at an iron pin in the Western margin of the road leading from Landrum to Gowansville, about three miles from Landrum and about one mile from Gowansville at the Northeastern corner of lot #2 in the sub-division of the Ralph S Crowell lands, which lot is being conveyed by deed of even date Beauford E Pace and running thence with the line of Pace property North 79 deg. 39 min. West 990 feet to an iron pin in an old abandoned road, the Northwest corner of said Pace tract; and in the line of property of K V Settle; thence with the old road and the Settle line six calls as follows North 36 deg. 12 min. West 65 feet,
