KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

As consideration for the rearrangement by the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, a New York corporation, of a section of its so-called Charlotte-Atlanta A & B Cables to accomodate the development of Greenville-Spartanburg Airport in Greenville and Spartanburg Counties, State of South Carolina, Greenville-Spartanburg Airport District acting by and through its Commission, hereby grants and conveys unto the said American Telephone and Telegraph Company, its associated and allied companies and their respective successors and assigns, a right-of-way and easement to construct, operate, maintain, replace and remove communications systems consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, testing terminals, conduits, manholes, markers and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantees may from time to time, require upon, across, over and under a strip of land 50 feet in width passing through the property of the Greenville-Spartanburg Airport District in Greenville and Spartanburg Counties, State of South Carolina, together with the following rights; of ingress and egress over and across the lands of the undersigned to and from said strip for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted; to clear and keep clear all trees, roots, brush and other obstructions from the surface and subsurface of said strip and to place surface markers upon said strip at locations agreeable to both the grantor and grantees.

The grantor for itself, its successors and assigns, hereby covenants and agrees that no structure (runways, parking facilities and the like excepted) shall be erected or permitted on said 50 foot strip of land, the centerline of which is described as follows:-
