POWER OF ATTORNEY



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Minnie L. Garrett, have constituted, made and appointed, and by these presents do constitute, make and appoint my daughter, Eunice Garrett Green, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name and stead, and to use, to ask, demand, sue for, levy, recover and receive all such sum and sums of money, debts, rents, goods, wares, dues, accounts, and other demands whatsoever, which are or shall be due, owing or payable to me or detained from me in any manner or ways or means whatsoever, hereby empowering my said attorney to collect and receive from the Southeastern Life Insurance Company any monies that I might be due by reason of an insurance policy No. 39646 which was issued on the life of my late husband, Mark Garrett, and wherein I was named beneficiary under the terms of said policy, and I further empower my said attorney, upon the receipt of said money, to pay any and all debts, including funeral bills and doctor bills incurred in behalf of my late husband, Mark Garrett.

Giving and granting unto my said attorney, by these presents, full and whole power, strength and authority, in and about the premises to have, use and take all lawful ways and means in my name for the recovery thereof; and upon the receipt of any such debts, dues, or sums of money aforesaid, acquittances or other sufficient discharges for me and in my name and in my stead to make, seal and deliver; and generally all and every other act and acts, thing and things, devise and devises in law whatsoever, needful and necessary to be done in and about the premises for me and in my name to do, execute and perform as fully, largely and amply to all intents

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
