CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

did on the 6th day of November, 1963, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **SELF-SERV CAR WASH INCORPORATED**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **1000 Lawyers Building, Greenville, S. C.**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is **to own and/or operate and/or maintain a Self-Service and/or semi-automatic for automatic motor vehicle wash service and/or business; to buy and sell, at wholesale and/or retail, any and all automotive or motor vehicle parts, products, accessories and motor vehicle wash machines, equipment, parts, products and accessories and to buy and sell, at wholesale and/or retail and all petroleum products for use in or for motor vehicles.**

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00)**-----Dollars payable **in cash or its equivalent on demand by the board of directors**

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **Two Thousand (2,000)** of the par value of **Fifty (\$50.00)**-----Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **29th** day of **October**, 1963, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **W. B. Price, James H. Price**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **W. B. Price**; as Vice-President, **James H. Price**; as Secretary, **James H. Price**; as Treasurer, **W. B. Price**

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by *bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **Greenville Piedmont** a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
