All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Memminger Street in Ward Five of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 14 on a plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book WW, at Page 605, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
