

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and no/100-----  
-----(\$500.00)----- Dollars,

to me paid by the said John A. Park

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said John A. Park

"All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Travelers Rest, known and designated as Lots 10 and 11 of the property of George W. Bridwell, shown on a plat thereof made by T. T. Dill, Surveyor, dated March 1946, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 129, and being described together according to said plat, as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwestern corner of the intersection of West Road and Second Avenue, and running thence along Second Avenue S. 16-09 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 10 and 25; thence with the joint rear line of Lots 10, 11, 24 and 25, S. 69-40 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 11, 12, 23 and 24; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 11 and 12, N. 16-09 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of West Road, joint front corner of Lots 11 and 12; thence along the southern side of West Road N. 69-40 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner."
