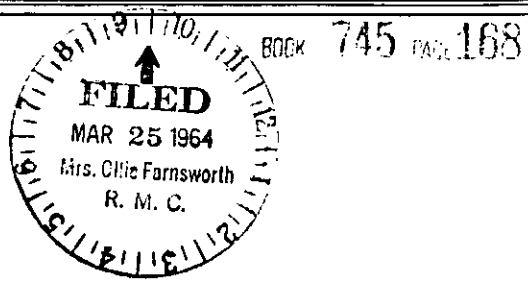

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, JULIAN CALHOUN

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of FIFTEEN HUNDRED & 00/100

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by WILLIAM E. HUNTLEY and HELEN M. HUNTLEY

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by  
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WILLIAM E. HUNTLEY  
and HELEN M. HUNTLEY, their heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being Lot No. 4 as shown on a plat entitled  
"Land Survey for Julian Calhoun, Greenville County, S.C." dated April  
2, 1959, made by J.Q. Bruce, Registered Surveyor, and being more par-  
ticularly described as follows:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the Eastern margin of Lanier Drive (sometimes referred to as Glenwood), said Lanier Drive leading from the Lake Lanier entrance road to Butterstreet, said beginning iron pin being located North 24 deg. 17 min. West 100 feet from the Northwestern corner of that certain lot conveyed by Julian Calhoun to Glen P. Morgan by deed dated April 27, 1957, recorded in Book 576, Page 363, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County; said beginning iron pin being also a corner common to Lots 4 and 5 as shown on the above referred to plat, and running thence from said beginning iron pin and with the Eastern margin of said Lanier Drive North 15 deg. 27 min. West 100 feet to an iron pin, a corner common to Lots 3 and 4 as shown on the above referred to plat; thence North 66 deg. 22 min. East 230 feet to an iron pin; thence South 23 deg. 23 min. East 100 feet to an iron pin; thence South 66 deg. 37 min. West 244 feet to the BEGINNING.

The above described lot is located approximately one mile South of the Town of Tryon.
