I, ADA FINDLEY HONOUR, of Greenville, South Carolina, do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my sister, Mary F. Longenbach as my true and lawful attorney in fact, with full power and authority

(a) To collect and receipt for all sums due to me.

(b) To endorse for deposit any checks payable to me and to deposit all sums collected in the bank to my account, with full authority to draw and sign checks against the same in her absolute discretion.

(c) To sell and convey and rent any and all property owned by me, expressly including the home on Watts Avenue in the City of Greenville.

(d) With full power and authority to mortgage the Watts Avenue property, if necessary, in her absolute discretion.

In addition to the above, but not limiting the same, my attorney in fact is vested with full power to manage all of my affairs of every nature and kind, and all acts and deed performed by her shall be valid and binding upon me as if performed by me in person..
