BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Claxton Drive at the joint front corner of lots Nos. 107 and 108 and running thence with the line of said lots, N. 37-15 W., 150 feet; thence S. 52-45 W., 90 feet; thence S. 37-15 E., 150 feet to an iron pin on Claxton Drive; thence with Claxton Drive N. 52-45 E., 90 feet to the point of beginning.
