All my undivided one-half (1/2)-interest in and to ALL that piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, situate and being in Fairview Township, State and County aforesaid, approximately three (3) miles southwest of the Town of Fountain Inn, known and designated as tract No. 19 according to plat of the J. B. Wasson Estate lands made by Paul Clark, Surveyor, dated September 4, 1961, and duly recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance in and for Greenville County in Plat Book YY, Page 21, and consisting of 4.82 acres, more or less, described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the intersection of the Fountain Inn-Fork Shoals Road and the Neely-Ferry Road and running thence with Neely-Ferry Road, N. 1 W. 60 feet; thence with said Neely Ferry Road N. 3 W. 200 feet; thence continuing with said road N. 11 W. 200 feet; thence S. 86-05 W. 1050 feet to a pin in the center of Fountain Inn-Fork Shoals Road, line of tract No. 20, said plat; thence with the center of said Fountain Inn-Fork Shoals Road, S. 70 W. 420 feet; thence continuing with the center of said road, S. 65 W. 340 feet; thence continuing with the center of said Road, S. 60 W. 370 feet to the point of beginning, and consisting of 4.82 acres, more or less.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

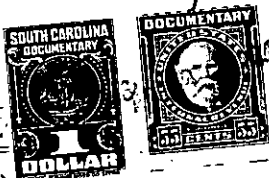
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.
