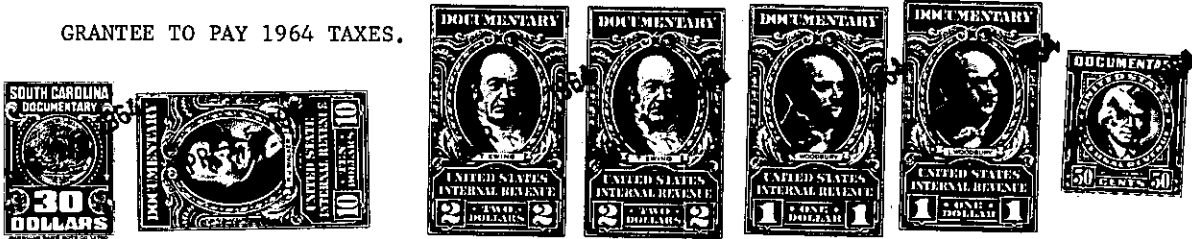
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the northerly side of Yeoman Street near the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as Lot No. 83 on plat of Chestnut Hills No. 1, as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book QQ, page 83, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northerly side of Yeoman Street, said pin being joint front corner of Lots 82 and 83 and running thence with the common line of said lots N 1-42 E 130 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 82 and 83; thence S 88-18 E 80 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 83 and 84,; thence with the common line of said lots S 1-42 W 130 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Yeoman Street, thence with the northerly side of Yeoman Street N 88-18 W 80 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
