RIGHT OF WAY AGREEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 28 day of April, 1964, by and between CONE MILLS CORPORATION, a North Carolina Corporation,

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$ 1.00 paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract(s) of land lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a strip of land.....68..... feet wide extending34..... feet on each side of a surveyed line which has been marked on the ground and extends from Station 15 + 47.4 as shown on the map hereinafter referred to and runs thence S 69-48 W 232.9 ft.; thence S 34-23 W 112.6 ft. to Station 12 + 01.9 as shown on said map.

By accepting this instrument, Grantee agrees to remove its 44 KV lines as shown by green lines on the attached print and to abandon its right of way for said lines.

The grantor does not hereby convey any rights which are inconsistent with or adverse to such rights as are held and claimed by South Carolina in connection with the Highway Right of Way substantially indicated and shown on the attached map.

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
