

close that strip of Paris Mountain Road directly behind lot #2 of the Greenville County property on plat book "J." at page 25 now owned by Homer Styles and Homer Styles does hereby agree that the County of Greenville shall no longer have any liability whatsoever to maintain said strip of land nor any liability for failure to maintain said strip of land for the past 20 or 25 years.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED, that Greenville County does hereby release Homer Styles, his heirs and assigns, from the force and effect of the restrictive or protective covenant pertaining to residences and prohibiting business on the Greenville County property above described in order that Homer Styles, his heirs and assigns, might hereafter use said property for any purpose which is lawful, including residential, business, industrial or otherwise. The effect intended herein is to cancel entirely any restriction as to residences or as to prohibiting businesses being used, operated or constructed on said premises above described.

The considerations for this instrument are the mutual benefits to be derived by the parties to this agreement.
