the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

All our undivided interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, designated as Tract No. 6 of the Minnie H. Wynn Estate, as shown on plat thereof made by J. C. Hill, and as revised January 28, 1963, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book CCC at page 171, and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, at a corner of lot No. 5 on said plat, and running thence N. 48-30 E. 406 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 7 on said plat; thence with line of said lot No. 7, S. 35-20 E. 526.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 30-45 W. 260 feet to an iron pin, at corner of lot No. 4 on said plat; thence with line of said lot No. 4, S. 42-10 W. 193.7 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot No. 5 on said plat; thence with line of lot No. 5 aforesaid, N. 32-25 W. 614.1 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 5.46 acres; be the same more or less.
