

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Orr Hill Street at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to J. P. Stevens & Co., Inc. and running thence along the Northeast side of Orr Hill Street the following courses and distances: N. 44-19 W., 126 feet to an iron pin; N. 50-39 W., 57 feet to an iron pin; N. 42-20 W., 70 feet to an iron pin; and N. 17-04 W., 87 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of property now or formerly belonging to J. P.
