All that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the Eastern side of Burns Street, being known and designated as Lot 9 as shown on plat of the property of S. O. Skelton, prepared by R. E. Dalton in August, 1919, recorded in Plat Book E, at Page 282, and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on an alley called Burns Street, 164.5 feet from the South side of Sullivan Street, and running thence S. 15-0 W. 54.8 feet; thence S. 88-47 E. 113.8 feet; thence N. 0-28 E. 52 feet to corner of Lot 8; thence along line of that lot, N. 88-25 W. 100.1 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in the City of Greenville shown on plat of property of S. O. Skelton as made in August of 1919 by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, said lot of land being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake at the Southeast corner of Lot No. 9 as shown on said plat, and running thence S. 88-47 E. 60 feet to a stake at corner of J. M. Dean Lot; thence along the line of said lot N. 0-23 E. 52 feet to a stake at the Southeast corner of Lot No. 7 as shown on said plat; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 7, 60 feet to a stake at the corner of Lot No. 9; thence along the line of Lot No. 9 S. 0-23 W. 52 feet to the place of beginning.
