All of that certain tract of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 2 as shown on plat of Property of Estate of Grace M. Whitmire, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "XX" at page 98, and being described as follows according to said plat:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on private road shown on said plat at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 6-12 E. 192.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 87-34 E. 293.3 feet to iron pin; thence N. 4-09 E. 162.9 feet along Granger line to iron pin; thence N. 88-51 W. to point on turn-around shown on said plat; thence with said turn-around, S. 58-05 W. 56.8 feet to a point; thence continuing with said turn-around S. 65-40 W. 78.8 feet to a point on said private road; thence continuing along said private road, N. 88-51 W. 188 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO a right-of-way and easement appurtenant for ingress and egress to use said private road shown on said plat which private road runs into the White Horse Road and which easement also includes the right to use said turn-around at the end of said road.
