not interested in taking this property or any of his associates if the Chamber of Commerce had any desire to exercise the option.

In as much as the directors felt it was not advantageous for the Chamber of Commerce to take this property, Mr. W. B. Lynn made the following motion:

> That the Greer Chamber of Commerce turn the option over to Mr. Laurens James, chairman of the Industrial Committee, to handle as he sees advisable.

> The motion was seconded by Mr. E. D. Dobson.

The motion was carried unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
