Morris, his Heirs and Assigns forever, all of our undivided interest in and to all of a Seven and Eleven One-hundredrths (7.11) acres, the 7.11 acres being all of Furman C. Morris8 interest in the whole of the emanuel Morris Estate consisting of 85.25 acres. all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles north of Batesville, lying on both sides of the road that leads off of the old Augusta Road (now known as the Brushy Creek Road) to the Pelham-Greenville Road, being bounded on the west by lands formerly of Mrs. Raines (now Hillsboro Inc.) and on all other sides by lands of the Emanuel Morris Estate, and having been cut out of a Forty acre tract conveyed to Emanuel Morris by deed from the Peoples Bank of Greenville, S.
