PARCEL NO. 21 (TRACT NO. 29)

A strip of land 60 feet wide and 230 feet long through other lands now or formerly of Oscar Townes, bounded on the north and south by other lands now or formerly of Sam Rosemond; on the east by property now or formerly of Washington, and on the west by property now or formerly of Oscar Townes; containing 0.32 of an acre, more or less.

PARCEL NO. 22 (TRACT NO. 28-A)

A strip of land 70 feet wide between parallel lines 35 feet on each side of the following described center line: Beginning at a point in the northwesterly line now or formerly of Rudolph & Allister Brockman South  $45^{\circ} 15'$  West, 545 feet from a point in the center line of Whitehorse Road, a common corner now or formerly of Rudolph & Allister Brockman and Sam Roseman, said point of beginning being at Station 89 + 99.5 on the arc of a 2 degree curve to the right, a distance of 18.79 feet northwesterly from the point of tangency of said curve; thence along said 2 degree curve 18.79 feet to a point of tangency with line bearing South  $57^{\circ} 06'$  East; thence South  $57^{\circ} 06'$  East, 281.71 feet to the point of curvature of a 1 degree curve to the right; thence along said 1 degree curve 65.5 feet to a point South  $46^{\circ} 15'$  West, 492 feet from a point in the center line of Whitehorse Road, a common corner now or formerly of Rudolph & Allister Brockman and Henry Washington, and containing 0.59 of an acre, more or less.

PARCEL NO. 23 (TRACT NO. 28)

A strip of land 70 feet wide between parallel lines, 35 feet on each side of the following described center lines: Beginning at a point in the northwesterly line now or formerly of Henry Washington, South  $46^{\circ} 15'$  West, 492 feet from a point in the center line of Whitehorse Road, a corner common to lands now or formerly of Henry Washington and Rudolph and Allister Brockman, said point of beginning being at Station 93 + 65.5 on the arc of a 1 degree curve to the right a distance of 65.5 feet southeasterly from the point of curvature from a tangent bearing South  $57^{\circ} 06'$  East; thence southeasterly along said curve 369 feet to a point South  $45^{\circ} 15'$  West, 494.9 feet from a point on the center line of Whitehorse Road, a common corner now or formerly of Henry Washington and G. H. Hunt; and containing 0.59 of an acre, more or less.

PARCEL NO. 24 (TRACT NO. 27)

A 70 foot strip of land extending 35 feet on each side of and parallel to the center line described as follows: Beginning at a point on the northwest property line of property now or formerly of G. H. Hunt South  $45^{\circ} 15'$  West 494.9 feet from the most northwesterly corner of the aforementioned tract on Whitehorse Road; thence along the arc of a 1 degree curve to the right 513 feet to a point on the southeastern property line of the aforementioned tract South  $45^{\circ} 15'$  West 520 feet from the northeastern corner of said tract on Whitehorse Road; containing 0.82 of an acre, more or less.

PARCEL NO. 25 (TRACT NO. 26)

A 70 foot strip of land extending 35 feet on each side of and

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
