C., lying on both sides of State Highway No. 14, and on both sides of the surfaced road that leads off of No. 14 and leads into the Pleasant Hill Community, and being shown and designated as tracts Nos 2, 3 and 4 on Plat of Property of B. C. Berry Estate, et. al., made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, June 12th 1963, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
