- That Spartan Court will be opened by the Corporation at its own expense, will be paved or surface treated by the Corporation at its own expense, said paving to be in conformity with the subdivision regulations of the City of Greenville and the Corporation will execute and deliver to the City a performance bond for the estimated cost of said paving in order to secure the City that it will conform to the specifications of the City.
- 2. That Spartan Court will be a private street and will be maintained in the future by the corporation at its own expense.
- That the Corporation agrees to provide drainage for surface water on its property shown on the above referred to plat in conformity with specifications of the Engineering
