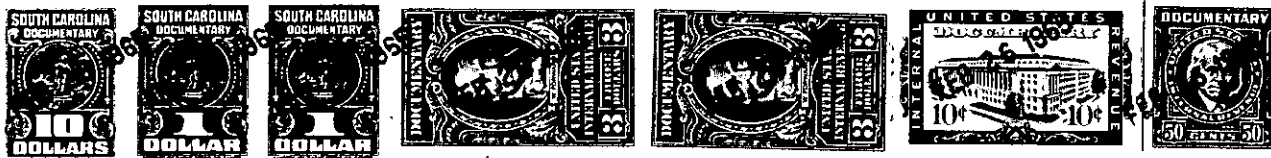

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jack D. Parker the following described property:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County State of South Carolina, about six miles west of the City of Greenville, near the Saluda River, containing 7.86 acres, more or less, according to plat of a subdivision of Cherry Investment Company made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a stake in road, corner of property now or formerly of Lonita Boggs, et al, and running thence N. 4-15 W. 1000 feet, more or less, to a stake in branch; thence along said branch N. 75 E. 248 feet to a point in line of property this date conveyed by grantor to Lawson Hall; thence running a new line along said Hall property S. 19-00 E. 854.4 feet to a stake in line of property now or formerly of Edwin and Maude Abbey Sparks; thence along said road S. 56-45 W. 199 feet; thence continuing along said road S. 67-45 W. 302 feet to the beginning corner.
