to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JACK E. ANTHONY and JEANETTE M. ANTHONY, Their Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

ALL that parcel, piece, or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the West side of Underwood Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 53 on Plat of Glenn Grove Park, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, May, 1924, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "F", Pages 232 and 233 and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Underwood Avenue at joint front corner of Lots 53 and 54, said pin also being 213.4 feet South from the Southwest corner of the intersection of Underwood Avenue and Laruens Road and running thence with the line of Lot 54, N. 74-12 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 15-48 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 52, S. 74-12 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Underwood Avenue; thence with the West side of Underwood Avenue, N. 15-48 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

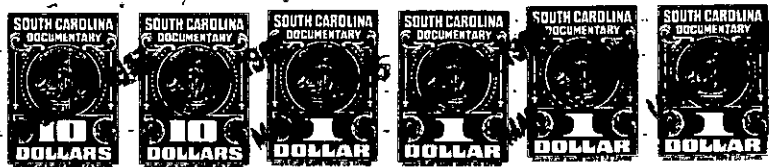
TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
