to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Bank of Greer, of Greer, South Carolina, a Corporation, its Successors and Assigns forever:

All that parcel or lot of land in the City of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the west side of South Main Street and on the south side of West Poinsett Street, formerly Emma Street, and having courses and distances according to a plat thereof made by H.S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, designated as property of John A. Robinson, as follows:

BEGINNING on an iron pin at edge of sidewalk on South Main Street, corner with City of Greer lot, formerly U.S. Post Office lot, and runs thence along the edge of sidewalk, N. 39-15 E. 173 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 58-39 W. 96 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31 E. 34.8 feet to an iron pin on inside of sidewalk on West Poinsett Street; thence with margin of sidewalk, N. 60-57 W. 110 feet, N. 62-34 W. 19.9 feet, and N. 70-22 W. 19 feet to an iron pin, corner of Virginia H. And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') ~~XXXX~~ and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

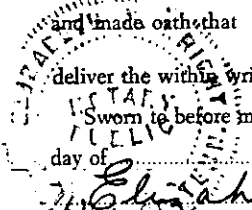

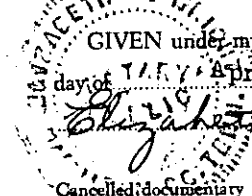
