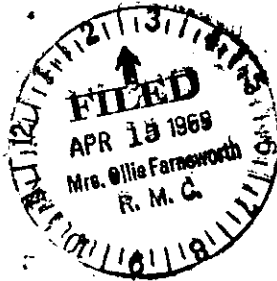

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this the 18th day of December, 1959, by and between the SOUTH CAROLINA STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, party of the first part, hereinafter called "Highway Department", and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, party of the second part, hereinafter called "Power Company";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Power Company is the owner of a 100KV transmission line in or near the City of Greenville, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on both sides of Interstate Highway No. 85, and being shown on print File No. 17-167, dated March 10, 1959, revised property added August 24, 1959, extending from Station 11+26.2 in a northeasterly direction to Highway Department's northerly right of way limit, as shown on the attached print and thereon indicated "Existing Line to be Removed", and is the owner of a right of way for the maintenance and operation of said transmission line; and

WHEREAS, said transmission line and right of way, to the extent shown by green line on the attached print, are located either upon property owned by Highway Department or upon property over which Highway Department owns a right of way for the maintenance and operation of its highway; and

WHEREAS, Power Company, at the request of Highway Department, proposes to remove a portion of its present line and to abandon its right of way for same, and to relocate same as hereinafter set out; and
