All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the southwestern side of Kennedy Drive, being shown and designated as Lot No. 20 on plat of Pine Hill Village recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "QQ", at page 168, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwestern side of Kennedy Drive, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20, and running thence with the southwestern side of Kennedy Drive, S. 60-38 E. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 29-22 W. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 60-38 W. 21 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-20 W. 57.6 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 29-22 E. 110 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning.
