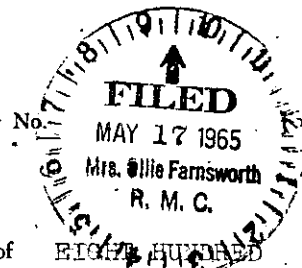

corporation of South Carolina, in hand paid by JAMES C. FAIR
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
JAMES C. FAIR a lot or parcel of ground, including perpetual
care, in Christ Church Cemetery, Greenville County, South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 12, 13, 14, 15
Section 104; the same being described and designated as above, in accordance with plat recorded in
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book ~~Page 300~~ DD Page 23

It is distinctly understood that said lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the white
race, and is sold and conveyed subject to all rules and regulations printed on the back hereof, and any addi-
tions or amendments for the government of the Cemetery which may hereafter be adopted.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted property to the said
James C. Fair, his

heirs and assigns forever; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations above referred to.

AND Christ Church Cemetery does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend the
said premises to the said James C. Fair, his heirs and assigns
against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof; subject, however, to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF Christ Church Cemetery has caused this instrument to be signed by its Presi-
dent and its seal affixed this 28th day of May, 1963.
