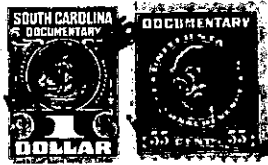

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

Dean E. Mullinax, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, in Austin Township, being known and designated as a portion of tract No. 4 of property of Marsmen, Inc., plat of same being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book S at Page 75, property conveyed herein having, according to recent survey by Carolina Engineering & Surveying Company, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the joint line of Tracts 1 and 4, the point of beginning being 247 feet northwest from S. C. Highway 14, and being in the center of County Road and running thence with said County Road N. 79-45 W. 151.5 feet to an iron pin in line of tract 4; thence with the new line through tract 4 N. 19-36 E. 366.0 feet; thence S. 51-18 E. 140 feet; thence S. 16-17 W. 296.1 to an iron pin in the center of County Road, the point of beginning, and containing one acre, more or less.
