Upon making the first payment agreed to hereunder the buyers shall be entitled to take possession of the premises and shall be entitled to retain possession of the same while this contract is in force and effect.

The buyers agree that they will pay all property taxes beginning January 1, 1966 and that they will insure the premises against loss by fire for the benefit of the seller in the minimum amount of \$4,000.00 commencing January 1, 1966.

It is further understood and agreed that should the buyers become in arrears for thirty days on any monthly payment, that this contract at the option of the seller shall become null and void and that the seller shall retain all amounts paid by the buyers as rent or liquidated damages.
