

WHEREAS, the said The South Carolina National Bank and Fannie H. Brawley, as Executors under the Will of Marion Brawley, Jr. are in the process of making distribution of the residuary estate under Item III of said Will to Francis Poe Brawley and Patricia Brawley Rose; and

WHEREAS, the real estate hereinafter described is being allotted to Francis Poe Brawley as a portion of his devise under said Item III of said Will, the said The South Carolina National Bank and Fannie H. Brawley, as Executors under the Will of Marion Brawley, Jr., in order to facilitate the apportionment of said property are now minded to quit claim unto the said Francis Poe Brawley all the right, title and interest of the decedent Marion Brawley, Jr. in and to the real estate hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the said John Jay Iselin and Richard Duane Iselin, stepchildren of the decedent Marion P. Brawley, Jr. who executed the aforesaid Disclaimer under date of September 30, 1964, were at that time both married and it is desirable to remove any question as to whether their wives had any dower interest to the real estate which should have been renounced at the time of the execution of the Disclaimer, and the wife of the said John Jay Iselin and the wife of the said Richard Duane Iselin are now minded to renounce any dower interest whatsoever that they might have had in said real estate; and

WHEREAS, the other male stepchild, William J. Iselin, of the said testator, was unmarried at the time he executed the Disclaimer under date of September 30, 1964; and

WHEREAS, Patricia Brawley Rose is also desirous of releasing by way of quit claim any right, title or interest that she may have acquired under Item III of the Will of Marion Brawley, Jr., as above set forth
