C. Adams on December 14, 1955 and being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJ, at Page 85, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Main Street at the corner of property of Knight and Weathers, which iron pin is situate 193.66 feet North-west of the intersection of Main Street and Case Street, and running thence along the line of property of Knight and Weathers S. 54-28 W. 47.2 feet to an iron pin on the C & G Railroad right-of-way; thence with said right-of-way, N. 43-33 W. 20.4 feet to an iron pin on said right-of-way at the corner of property owned by Stewart; thence along the Stewart property, N. 54-02 E. 50.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southwestern side of Main Street; thence with Main Street, S. 35-58 E. 20.5 feet to the point of beginning.
