in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and ~~other considerations~~ and for the purpose of dividing Dollars the estate property of the late Lillie H. Harrison, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by William A. Martin

in the State aforesaid (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William A. Martin

All our right, title and interest in and to all that piece, parcel and tract of land lying and being on Raburns Creek in Fairview Township, Greenville County, S. C., containing 79 acres, more or less, and being a part of the old homestead of John R. Harrison. The tract of land herein conveyed being known as Lot No. 3 of a division of the said old homestead according to a survey made by J. A. Adams in 1909. According to the said survey the lands herein conveyed has the following metes and bounds: Commencing at a stake in center of Nash Mill Road and running thence N. $66\frac{3}{4}$ E to a stone on J. R. Thomason corner, on side of road; thence, S. 86 E., 18.30 to stone 3X; thence, N $9\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.54 to a pine 3 X; thence, N. $12\frac{1}{2}$ W., 6.27 to a stone 3X; thence, N. $46\frac{1}{2}$ W., 13.57 to a pin 3X; thence, S. 86 W., 7.50 to a stone 3X; thence, N. $64\frac{3}{4}$ W. 6.87 to a Sweet Gum 3X; thence, N. 29 W. 11.16 to a Pine 3X; thence N. 6 W. 1.40 to a White Oak 3X; thence, N. $16\frac{1}{2}$ W., 1.30 to center of Creek; thence, S. 68 W., 2.65 to a stone 3X; thence, S. 3 E., 4.00 to a stone; thence, S. 44 W., 9.50 to a stone 3X; thence, S. 3 W. to the center of Nash Mill road; thence, along said road to the beginning corner.
