

V. To deposit and withdraw for the purposes hereof, in either my said attorney's name or names, or my name or jointly in both our names, or jointly with any other person or persons, in or from any banking or savings and loan institution, any funds, negotiable papers, or moneys which may come into my said attorneys' hands as such attorney or which I now or hereafter may have on deposit or be entitled to.

VI. GIVING AND GRANTING, unto my said attorneys, or either of them, full power and authority to and perform all and every act, deed, matter and thing whatsoever about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intent and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present; the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the fully complete, and general power herein and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorneys, or either of them, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.
